A programmatic and design charrette was undertaken with the Greater Vancouver Regional District for Brae Island Regional Park. The parks management plan called for the development of the campground based on sustainable development principles with education by example being an important component of the facilities and operation. The planting and campground design ensured that the Fraser River, Gallery Forest and natural beauty of the island were enhanced to attract new and returning visitors. The parking lot and access roads were studied to ensure a safe, highly legible experience for the user. Elevating the campground experience increased attendance and revenues so that park operations were financially sustainable and the site would be enjoyed for years to come.
