This brownfield site was a former Lafarge sand and gravel pit and industrial operation, converted to a multi-field tournament complex, attracting teams from all over Western Canada for soccer, track and field, rugby, football, and field hockey tournaments. The sports facilities are integrated within the established Town Centre Park and Stadium, which includes ecological design to reduce the urban heat island and on site storm water runoff.

Working closely with the City of Coquitlam, Mike Enns led the design team through concept to construction of all outdoor amenity spaces that supported the sports fields, including arrival plazas, team gathering areas, canopy structures, and amenities for participants. Wide trails connect activity areas with major tree canopy planting and hillside naturalization planting. The brownfield site was a former Lafarge sand and gravel pit and industrial operation.
