

# Telus Gardens Atrium

The previously under utilized 8-storey high atrium was re-branded to become a creative lifestyle experience: tapas, bar/lounge, garden, yoga, sales and technology. Inspired by the textures, moods, and colours of Emily Carr, an undulating boardwalk leads one through a forested canopy and crosses a symbolic stream. Custom detailing, surfacing, lighting, art, and interior plantings were carefully woven together to enhance the visitor experience.

Project Landscape Architect Mike Enns, together with Cornelia Oberlander and Dialog, were hired by Westbank Corp to transform Telus Atrium into a showcase presentation centre for the Telus Garden multi-use development.
